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you wish to be recognized?

SENATOR KAHLE: Mr. Speaker and members, yes, I support the Landis amendment and also the Schmit amendment. We do have a problem with transportation in my area. We have a minibus or a handibus that takes care of the elderly. It started when I had something to do with it so I know a little bit about it. It has turned out very well and will be even more valuable in the future because for one thing, many of the elderly today are finding themselves unable to finance or maintain an automobile so they need transportation. Many others should not be driving an automobile when they get up in years so the handibus is able to get these people to the doctor and get them around for some recreation and a few other things and if we are going to divide this up, I am usually fighting a rural-urban battle, but today I am certainly hoping that we can cooperate and provide transportation. I know that transportation is needed in the cities and I know that Lincoln for instance has put on some new buses and the people are riding the buses more and more every month so we are on the right track I believe, by providing transit transportation, not just in Lincoln and Omaha but across the State of Nebraska and if we want to save energy this is one way to do it and I do not object to taking a \$1,000,000 out of this fund for this purpose and for whatever is needed. So I hope you will support the Landis amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well now, first of all, the Landis amendment has not been officially accepted by the Legislature so we need to clear that up and I think the way we clear it up first of all, Senator DeCamp, do you have an amendment to the Schmit amendment?

SENATOR DE CAMP: I do, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Well, just a moment. No, I think we had better take Landis' amendment first and then come back to Senator DeCamp's.
