be your business partner or someone like that. It has to be either the spouse or a dependent for whom then the life insurance would be yielded up in the event there was a claim against the life insurance and in only those cases then can you keep up to \$5000 of the casu value. Those are the changes that are in LB 901. That is the language, I assume, Senator Murphy that you used or rather is being put into your 940 at the behest of Senator DeCamp.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, do you have anything further on your opening? All right, the Chair recognizes Senator Newell. Senator Newell. Senator Chambers. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Well, I have two points I would like to make. First, if the Fire Marshal, Mr. Barnett, is listening I would give you advance notice there will probably be an unexplained fire in Senator Chambers' file cabinet, and I can tell you who is going to do it. Quite seriously, however, the point that Senator Chambers makes in his article and it is sure good to see my name in print again, is quite different from this as Senator DeCamp indicated. This bill not only had an interim study, it had full committee hearings and the whole bit. The objection that I had raised and I would raise it again was an attempt to insert into a bill material that had not had a public hearing and had no announcement and was strictly a spur of the moment action, and now having absolved myself of all sin, I will sit down.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: After the confession, I move the previous question.

PRESIDENT: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 7 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, debate ceases. Senator DeCamp, you may close.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I will try to be relatively brief. Senator Hoagland raised a question when he said, Johnny, why are you doing this...we could do this next year. I have about three reasons why I think it should be done now, why I have pushed it at this particular moment. Number one,
