

analyses conducted pursuant to the state water planning and review process. We all know about that. Page 28, Section 27, factors to include in analyses of the water policies are specified and you note them on page 28, line 6. Only about three more explanations now. Section 28, page 29, legislative intent is expressed that the analysis request be incorporated into the existing schedule where appropriate if not already included. Last of all Section 26-29 of the bill would be repealed by July 31, 1982. The bill as presently drafted includes a repealer clause and also the emergency clause. That, Mr. Chairman, is the best of my ability to explain the content of the bill before us in discussion this morning. I move for the adoption of the committee amendments.
