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it fully? Now there are people that do but we believe this is attacking that question with reality, Senator Venditte.

SENATOR VENDITTE: Senator Carsten, very good, thank you very much.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: I wasn't going to say anything on this except there are a couple of good senators that have made some statements that I think they ought to understand and I will let you know that I have never received a homestead exemption for the senior citizens. In the World Herald, I see it quotes me today as living off of social security. I have been in the Legislature twelve years. I realize I don't live off the \$400 a month that I got here but somehow somebody ought to have caught on that I have been here. It seems odd. Senator Kahle, when you say that the amount of money that you get back to every individual across this state who owns a home, that credit means nothing. You do not know my family that have three little children hanging at the feet of every one of them. I have four of them that have that and that \$28 is \$28 in my town. That \$28 is an awfully lot. That is almost thirty loaves of bread. That is enough bread to feed them for two weeks or a month. When people come along and tell me that \$28, \$30 means nothing, they don't know, they don't realize, they have never had to go out and buy, they aren't poor. This scheme that I have called here today, never in the day of any man I have seen in the history of this nation has there been such a broad scheme to take from the people that are working and give to those that are not and do not have a tax to pay on their homestead. It is wild. It is one of the most liberal I have ever seen. If we follow it this year like this, probably next year we will put it in there. There will be instead of \$240, there will be \$500. Let me tell you the \$240 that they are talking about, the taxes on my house are over \$1,200. I am sixty-seven. This year because I have not sold my crop, it is sitting in the granaries there, I am eligible for the homestead exemption, \$240 off of mine would only be...would still leave me \$1,000 yet to pay. Let me tell you, friends, kill this bill. Pass that homestead exemption that Senator Labeledz has brought and we've got a good one going. It has brought the homes up to \$40,000. If the people who do not own a home, I've got no obligation on property tax. Perhaps they pay through the rent but they have other ways of getting their money, certainly we don't need to bring this monstrosity up and consider it anymore.
