SENATOR DeCAMP: Okay, so at the recommendations of the Appropriations Committee. Who do we have on the Appropriations Committee or whoever offered the amendments, I guess, I am asking, who do I ask who can explain to me what we were correcting so I can know? We've got some major amendments completely changing a system and I need to crack down who to ask to learn. Okay, Senator Kelly, maybe you can help me. What were the compelling reasons, the evidence, the documentation that we needed to completely change things?

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, the compelling reason was so poor and so low on the totem pole that I voted against it.

SENATOR De CAMP: Well you are not helping me much here, Kelly. We've got to find somebody that can help me. How about, let's see, Shirley? Shirley voted against it. Well, Senator Dworak voted for it. Maybe he can help. What was the evidence that we needed to do or what was the problem because the Attorney General, I felt he would know about as much about this as anybody and he told me, heck, the thing is working perfectly, one of the best operating boards we have, so...

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator DeCamp, the reason I voted for the amendments, it made a lot of sense to me. When you have consumers bringing complaints into a board with no consumer representation, only those people they are complaining against and so the portion of the amendment that has an equal amount of representation, consumer board members, three, three, with supposedly a neutral member making it a seven man board sort of indicated to me it made a little sense and that is why I personally supported the amendment...(interruption.)
