SENATOR LEWIS: That is one of the best moves you ever made, Murph.

SENATOR MURPHY: It turned out times two before we were done but I think that is a vague statement and should be clarified along with whatever other amendments we are issuing here and I'd just as soon one of you architects did that.

SENATOR LEWIS: I hate to use the old Carpenter expression but I am running out of time and I will be happy to look at that and talk with you and try to do it on Select File.

SENATOR MURPHY: You are a lovable sort.

SENATOR CLARK: There is one minute left on the bill, Senator Schmit, do you want to close on your amendment?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Go ahead.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the bill be advanced. I have no closing. Oh, adopt the amendment, sorry.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion before the House is the adoption of the Schmit amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Schmit's amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The motion passed. The amendment is adopted. Senator Lewis moves the bill be advanced to E & R. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 1 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CLARK: Motion passed. The bill is advanced. LB 865.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 865 was introduced by Senator Murphy. (Read.) The bill was read on January 22, referred to Banking Committee. It was advanced to General File. I have no committee amendments. I do have an amendment from Senator George.
