

PRESIDENT: I don't know, this is on Select File.

SENATOR CLARK: It is still going to be tough.

PRESIDENT: It is going to be close no matter what happens, that is true.

SENATOR CLARK: I would think that we ought to suspend the rules at least and take it up and vote it down or whatever it is.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Haberman. Do you wish to speak on this?

SENATOR HABERMAN: I wish to speak on either one of the bills.

PRESIDENT: Anyone else want to speak on the motion to..... Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: I call for the question.

PRESIDENT: I think that is all. Thanks, Senator Dworak. There are no other persons wishing to speak so, Senator Warner, you may close on the motion to suspend the rules.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would just ask that we take the issue up and dispose of it today, up or down.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to suspend Rule 7, Sec.3 in order to take up the kill motion on LB 722 today or immediately following if it is successful. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. This requires 30 votes. Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I will ask for a Call of the House so that we can dispose of the issue.

PRESIDENT: All right, make a record and all those in favor of Calling the House vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. The Sergeant at Arms will bring all members back into the Chamber. All non-legislative personnel will leave the floor. All legislators will return to your desks and register your presence. The House is under Call. Senator Warner, do you wish to get any call ins first?

SENATOR WARNER: Call ins are fine, Mr. President.
