

PRESIDENT: We will accept call in votes at this time.

CLERK: Senator Johnson voting aye. Senator Stoney voting aye. Senator Koch, you had voted aye, Senator. Senator Wesely voting aye. Senator Reutzel voting aye. Senator Marsh, want to vote no? You had voted aye, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Register your presence please. Senator Chronister, will you register your presence please.

CLERK: Senator Johnson changing from yes to no. Senator Haberman changing from no to yes. Senator Hoagland voting yes.

PRESIDENT: We are looking for Senator Goodrich, George, Senator Wagner, Senator Newell, Senator Chambers, Senator Lewis, Senator Goodrich, Senator Wagner.
