LB 632, 848

you are closing on your amendment to 848.

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, Mr. President, and members of the body, basically this is just the registration fee. The bill, as it stands presently, does not increase the license fees at all. This would raise the registration fee from \$10 to \$15 to pay for the yearly application. Basically, that is a little less than the estimated cost of the processing of those applications, and the state shouldn't have to pay for it.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Marsh, your light is on. Do you wish to speak? Okay, the motion is the adoption of the Newell amendment to 848. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Newell. Have you all voted? Okay. I am going to record the vote. Are you ready? Okay, record the vote.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost. Any other amendments to 848?

CLERK: No, sir, I have nothing further.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, whose bill is it?

CLERK: It's the Miscellaneous Subjects bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, do you want to advance the bill?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I move we advance the bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the advancement of 848 to E & R for Engrossment. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The bill is advanced. The next is LB 632.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 632.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move the E & R amendments to LB 632.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed no. The motion is carried. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit now moves to amend
