SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is to return the bill for the specific amendment. Are you....Senator DeCamp, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I love Senator Murphy's idea. You may remember I got the doggone thing repealed a couple years and J. J. vetoed it, but I have to raise a point of order unfortunately, reluctantly, etcetera, etcetera, etcetera. You've got a constitutional problem. You may remember the Denney decision a year or so ago about the five days, a new idea, a new bill. I think you are running smack into it. It hasn't been....this idea has not been in a bill itself in any form and it's....it quotes you section 14 of the Constitution of Nebraska which is what they....they hung one of the other major bills of the Legislature on the five legislative day rule and I think you are into that. So, do what you want, but I think you better be aware of it. If you got the bill and put it in, I think it is going to be void anyway.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Who called the question? The question has been called for. The motion is the return of the bill. That is what we are voting on. All those in favor of the return of the bill....Senator Murphy, do you wish to close?

SENATOR MURPHY: Yes. I think the issue of germaneness has been certainly clarified and that it would be brought up is unfortunate, because certainly this bill is completely germane. But I think in the last two or three days in here we have had evidence of what happens under the current commission that we have. It is a harrassment. It is unfortunate. It accomplishes nothing. It has done nothing except pile up paper work and expense year after year. I think this is an opportunity to dispose of it. I think if this bill in its amended form lies on our desks for the required one day before Final Reading that we have answered the Constitutional problem with it. But certainly, this is a useless appendage of state government that should be removed and a very simplistic, very factual replacement put in its place so that there is a financial accountability. I would ask that you return the bill for this amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion before the House is the return of the bill for the Murphy amendment. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you
