SENATOR NEWELL: I would like to have a Call of the House.

SENATOR CLARK: A Call of the House?

SENATOR NEWELL: A Call of the House and a roll call vote.

SENATOR CLARK: A Call of the House has been requested. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 15 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Do you want a roll call vote?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I would like to have a roll call vote.

SENATOR CLARK: Let's have a roll call vote. Go ahead and call the roll. I'm sorry the vote has already been announced on that. We cannot do that but we will have a roll call vote on the amendment if you would like. The vote had already been announced on the Call of the House. Do you want a roll call vote on your amendment?

SENATOR NEWELL: Yes, I do.

SENATOR CLARK: All right, call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 1817 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 26 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Motion lost. What is the next amendment?
