

our ability to make proposals in the changes in the law. Because we are of one house we have tilted the scale against the passing of a bill. We have tilted it so far to where the proposer falls off the table. We have an opportunity now in supporting Senator DeCamp and Senator Marvel and the Unicameral by voting to overrule the Chair to right this balance so that we can finish this system with a little decorum and with some good law. I solicit your support in closing for Senator DeCamp.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is shall the Chair be overruled and the issue has to do with whether or not the amendments that Senator Newell has offered to LB 882 are germane. That is the issue, as the Chair understands the issue. Now, shall the Chair be overruled is the issue. Senator Newell, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR NEWELL: I would like to ask for a point of order. The point of order is simply this, Mr. President. Senator DeCamp is offering in one fell swoop to rule all my amendments out of order. Now the question of germaneness has to be applied individually to those amendments and I think that what Senator DeCamp is trying to do with his motion is simply to change the rules with just a bare majority of those present and voting. Consequently I think his motion which would say all my amendments are not germane is out of order and I think that that point is a very legitimate and honest point. Now I told Senator DeCamp earlier that I have a kill motion coming up next. Senator DeCamp wants to take up that kill motion, try to suspend the rules. He can do that. I made that very clear earlier and Senator DeCamp has chosen to do with a majority of votes what he knows he cannot do with thirty votes or what he is unwilling to do with 30 votes and I think that that is a distortion of the process.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Newell, it is my understanding that we are dealing with one amendment. That was the issue and that was the decision that the Chair had made. I'm not talking about all amendments. I am talking about one amendment.

SENATOR NEWELL: Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is, shall the Chair be overruled. All those in favor of overruling the Chair vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The motion is, shall the Chair be overruled. Have you all voted? Excuse me? I'm sorry? Record the vote.
