I know the things I have said tonight have probably made me some enemies in the back of this room but never have I stood on the floor of this Legislature.....seeing the people here rob me of \$2 million bucks and walk away and smile about it and say they have accomplished something that never has been done before.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Newell. Senator Newell. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Chairman, I sit around here most of the day and try to ameliorate a problem but I think it has to be for the record and seldom do I ever speak for the place from which I come. I'm not that provincial and I'm not that parochial but I have to tell you this. School district #54, the system I live in, since we have put 518 in and I was one of those who supported it, has lost over \$13,000,000 of valuation. This afternoon I couldn't even offer an amendment to try to hold something harmless because certain people out here who the Attorney General said it is unconstitutional but for them to replace what they have lost will cost them at least three mills and I know where the mills are going to go, right on the houses and I think there is a terribly inequitable solution to a problem. This morning we argued over state aid and fairness but I will tell you what, gentlemen, I didn't rape you that much on 486 but I am going to watch your votes when we get over there on 1002 and 486 and see where integrity and honor lies. Thank you.
