SENATOR CLARK: You have one minute.

SENATOR KELLY: ...and I would guess that it would be totally controlled by the judiciary side of our government and that, as an example, I would expect that that would probably be in the neighborhood of \$5,000, \$7,500 at the most, and with that closing, please support this amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the adoption of the Kelly amendment to 993. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting no.

SENATOR CLARK: Have you all voted?

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, that is too many that is not voting. I would ask for a Call of the House.

SENATOR CLARK: A Call of the House has been asked for. All those in favor of a Call of the House will vote aye, all those opposed will vote nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: The House is under Call. All legislators will take their seats and register in please. Have you all registered in please. Do you want a roll call vote, Senator Kelly? Senator Schmit, Senator Lamb, Senator Goodrich, Senator Haberman. Senator Simon, will you register in please? Senator Venditte. Senator Haberman, will you register in please? Do you want a roll call vote, Senator Kelly? Senator Lamb is the only one missing.

SENATOR KELLY: Please, Mr. Speaker, I request a roll call vote.

SENATOR CLARK: Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See pages 1843 and 1844, Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President. Yes, sir.
