CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the amendments which Senator Beutler and I offer do some things that were attempted earlier on General File. First of all, they do adopt an amendment that Senator Hoagland had suggested, at least a portion of the amendment that Senator Hoagland had suggested with respect to advertising and they would allow an individual to give the type of advertisements that Senator Hoagland had discussed earlier. They make a few minor changes in the advertising code that is in existence now for the operation of this particular board and that regulate this particular industry and they also apply the uniform trade...deceptive trade practices act to the motor vehicle industry and Senator Beutler and I have worked through these amendments. We have come to an agreement and understanding that they would be workable and acceptable. We have worked with the representatives from the industry and they likewise would be in support of the amendments. With that I would ask you to adopt them. I would be happy to try to respond to any questions that you might have but I think if you are familiar with the uniform trade practices act as most people are that it is self-explanatory. Thank you.
