SENATOR CULLAN: I guess we would just recess until the bills are processed or whatever, that is all, and finish this, the last bill would have been the last one to move off of Select.

SPEAKER MARVEL: As near as I can determine Pat, it will take at least an hour and a half of recess. Okay, we should try to recess to about 11:00 if we are going to recess. Otherwise those bills will not be processed. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, I'm a bit confused. We were running through the list on Select File and we are recessing, does that mean that we are leaving Select File?

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR KELLY: So we wouldn't go back to Select File to take these few bills that are left and they would be dead for this year.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, that is my understanding. Is that right Mr. Clerk?

SENATOR KELLY: That would be my understanding and that is the reason I would oppose the recess motion.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, I think this is highly irregular and unfair. There should be some sense of fairness about this, whether you like the bills or not coming up. I certainly do object to this and waiting until this hour to object.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the Clerk reminds me that it is not debatable so we will have to submit it to a vote. The motion is that we recess coming back about 11:00 but the motion is that we recess. All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Okay. Shall we record the vote? Record the vote.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 25 nays Mr. President.
