CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1983 and 1984 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 2 nays, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL PRESIDING

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion carried with the emergency clause attached. Now on Final Reading the Clerk will read LB 824.

CLERK: (Read LB 824 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. 824 on Final Reading. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on pages 1984 and 1985 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 1 nay, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. The Clerk will now read on Final Reading LB 865.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 865 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 1985 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The bill is declared passed on Final Reading. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. Speaker, members of the Unicameral, respectfully I ask unanimous consent to add Murphy's name to any bills that I may have left before the Unicameral.

SPEAKER MARVEL: So ordered. Senator Lewis.
