AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to require the use of passenger restraint systems as prescribed; and to provide penalties.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Any person furnishing child care who is subject to licensure under section 71-1902, when transporting, in a motor vehicle, any children for whom care is being furnished, shall use an approved child passenger restraint system for each child, except that a seat safety belt may be used for any child over age one. Any person violating this section shall be guilty of an infraction as defined in section 39-602 and shall have his or her license to furnish child care revoked or suspended by the Department of Public Welfare. For purposes of this section approved child passenger restraint system shall mean a restraint system which meets Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 213 as developed by the National Highway Safety Administration as of the effective date of this act.
