PRESIDENT: That is right, you may.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I remember when we adjourned sine die this last time, I had difficulty making that motion and making comments in regards to it. SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I move that a committee of six members be appointed to escort the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to the legislative chamber for the purpose of administering the Oath of Office to the officers of the Legislature.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to appoint a committee to escort the Chief Justice to swear in the officers of the Legislature. All those in favor of Senator Nichol's motion signify by saying aye. Opposed nay. Motion carries and the Chair will appoint the following committee to bring the Chief Justice in for such purpose of swearing in the officers. Senator Nichol, you will Chair the committee. Senators Stoney, Beutler, Landis, Vard Johnson and Senator Hoagland. Will the committee retire to the rear of the chamber and escort the Chief Justice. The Legislature will stand at ease until the committee returns with the Chief Justice.
