PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President and members, I think most of you know me after being here twelve years. I think you have been around when I have chaired committees. I think you know I am going to be fair. I am sure that Shirley would be fair also, but I am really honored and will be honored if you would vote for me for this office. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: We will proceed then with the election for Chairperson of the Committee on Committees. Where are the ballots, Mr. Clerk? The ballots are being distributed and we will proceed then with the election of nominees Senator Marsh and Senator Clark. The Chair will appoint a Telling Committee. Senator Rumery, will you Chair that committee, and Senator Pirsch, will you serve on the Telling Committee and Senator Sieck. Senator Pirsch, Senator Sieck and Senator Rumery as Chairman. Has everyone cast their ballots now? Has each of you cast a ballot? Report the results of the election, Mr. Clerk.
