I think you can judge us by the things that we have done. I sincerely mean it when I say that somebody representing my point of view must be on the Executive Board. There are issues which we will deal with this Session that we do not touch during other Sessions. One of them is re-apportionment and there are others. So I hope that you will consider what I have said, consider the nature of the type of body that a Legislature is. It should be a miniature portrait of the society which is being represented. Having said that, I will take my seat and ask that you vote in my behalf.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President and colleagues, I first want to thank Senator Koch for the fine nomination speech. Second, I would pledge to you that I would work very hard in your behalf to make sure that each Senator is adequately taken care of to his needs. Third, I can only give you my past track record, my reputation for my fairness, for my honesty and, fourth, I would very much appreciate your support. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I will be brief, but I say it is an honor for me to be nominated by Senator Nichol for this position. I will try to be fair and just at all times when serving on this committee, and I would certainly appreciate your support.

PRESIDENT: The Chair will appoint the Tallying Committee for this election. Senator Landis, Chairman; Senator Maresh and Senator Newell, if you would be the Tallying Committee. So proceed with the distribution of the ballots and the election for Vice Chairman of the Executive Board. The Clerk will report the results of the election of Vice Chairman of the Executive Board.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers receives 2 votes, Senator Dworak receives 27 votes, Senator Hefner receives 20 votes.

PRESIDENT: The results having been reported the Chair declares Senator Dworak elected Vice Chairman of the Executive Board. The Chair recognizes Senator Maresh.
