The Chair will await a motion. When the Clerk reports the results of the caucuses we will await a motion to declare elected those persons named by the caucuses. The Clerk will report on the results of the caucusing.

CLERK: Mr. President, from the 1st caucus group Senators Schmit and Carsten have been nominated. From the 2nd Senator Fitzgerald and Senator Pirsch, and from the 3rd District Senator Clark and Senator Nichol.

PRESIDENT: All right, the Chair entertains a motion to approve the six names mentioned from the three caucuses. Senator Clark, do you want to make that motion so we can proceed?

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, I move that the names be accepted and appointed, and elected.

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark moves to approve the nominations of the three caucuses. Is there any discussion? All those in favor will vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the approval of all six names submitted by the caucuses. Record the vote.

CLERK: What do you want, Bob?

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark voting aye. He said he is not recording.

CLERK: Are you pressing the green button?

PRESIDENT: It is recording nay.

CLERK: Do you want to vote aye? All right.

PRESIDENT: Since he made the motion he wants to vote for it.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Clark voting aye. 41 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the reports.

PRESIDENT: All right, the motion carries and the six named in the caucus reports are hereby declared elected. The Chair recognizes Senator Rumery.

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that we proceed to the election of the remaining twelve members of the Committee on Committees and that we authorize the members residing within each of the four districts as numerated in Rule 3, Section 17,
