stated in advance what I was going to do. I did it. Now, you say that is just the way you are explaining it. Maybe so, but let's check Johnny's record. When Johnny said, hey, this is a political war over here in Vietnam, we are not allowed to win, we are not allowed to lose, Johnny put his money where his mouth was and he ran for public office from Vietnam. In fact, as most of you know I won the campaign without coming back to the United States, while in Vietnam. I don't know how many of you remember but I sure bet Senator Warner does, and Senator Ernie Chambers, because I used myself as bait again and we convicted the guy the first time in 102 years that anybody has been convicted of bribery in the State of Nebraska. The Legislature squandered, I don't know, twenty to thirty thousand while they were doubting whether what I was saying was the truth, but it proved and the very prominent banker was convicted. I put my money where my mouth was that time. When the Vietnam war broke out again I made the statement that soldiers that had babies in Vietnam had the responsibility to take care of them some way or another, or get them out, the members of this body who were with me then in 1975 kind of remember. Johnny, at his own expense, went to Vietnam, took ten days out of the Legislature, organized Operation Babylift, brought home 2,800 babies, including one for Senator Maresh, Maresh's daughter. When Johnny said the chain stores are meat price fixing and nobody would do anything about it from Attorney General on down, Johnny teamed up with Loren Schmit, we filed a law suit and we won the doggone thing and proved it and stopped the practices and won a big pile of money for farmers to use in the future to s'op these practices. So when Johnny says, I am going to do something, I usually use myself and I go out on the line. I said I was going to prove that law is a hoax. All the people that were defending it are now claiming it is the biggest hoax. It is laden with loopholes. So row I am going to tell you the rest of the story.
