I believe that Richard Maresh has demonstrated the ability as well as the enthusiasm to continue to do the work of chairing the Business and Labor Committee. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Are there any other nominations for the Chair position for the Business and Labor Committee? Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, seeing that no one else is standing on their feet to place a nomination I move the nominations cease and a unanimous ballot be cast for Senator Richard Maresh as Chairman of the Business and Labor Committee.

PRESIDENT: Motion has been made by Senator Kremer to close the nominations and declare Senator Maresh elected by unanimous ballot for Business and Labor Committee. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor of closing the rominations and declaring Senator Maresh elected unanimously will vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 mays on the motion to cease nominations and to declare Senator Maresh the victor by unanimous vote.
