In addition, I will certify to this body tomorrow the fact that the caths and the bonds have been filed for the State Board of Education, the Regents of the University of Nebraska as well as the members of the Public Service Commission, the Workmens Compensation Court Judge and three members of the Supreme Court. So, Mr. Speaker, I tender to you in accordance with the Constitution the requirement to certify these election returns and I present to the Speaker, should he wish to see them, all of the abstracts of the election returns.
