PRESIDENT LUEDTKE PRESIDING

PRESIDENT LUEDTKE: Prayer by Chaplain Palmer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will come to order. We will have roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators DeCamp, Fitzgerald and Cullan would like to be excused until they arrive. Mr. President, Senator Labeledz would like to be excused until she arrives.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel. Speaker Marvel, we do not have a quorum yet so we have to wait a couple of moments. Let us see how many we need. Now we do. Okay, record the presence.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Quorum being present, are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, now the Chair recognizes Speaker Marvel.

SPEAKER MARVEL: I move that the rules in effect on the sixtieth legislative day of the Eighty-sixth Legislature, Second Session, be adopted for today only, January 8, 1981.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion to adopt temporary rules for this day only as was done yesterday, the first legislative day. Is there any discussion? Any questions? All those in favor of adopting the temporary rules signify by voting aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of temporary rules, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The temporary rules are adopted. Are there any messages, reports or communications, Mr. Clerk?
