these words can only be expressed in a bill. A bill cannot carry two subjects. An amendment cannot be offered to a bill if it is not germane to the main subject matter of the bill. So there are various types of restrictions of a technical nature that already exist to limit us in terms of what we can do. I think that we should acknowledge that there are differing levels of talents and abilities. There are occasions when some of us will have a great deal to say and other occasions when we will have nothing to say but to try to establish an arbitrary rule which says in all seasons...

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have thirty seconds.
