SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, just a short note. It is interesting to hear Senator DeCamp's remarks. Basically what he is saying is in his opinion suspension of the rules is necessary for cloture. Well, I guess all I would ask of you is be consistent. If you were against cloture, then surely you are in favor of making it more difficult to suspend the rules because that is, in effect, our cloture motion. Let's put it to you that way. Put those two things in order and take a consistent position.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, the motion is the adoption of the amendment found on page 23. Amendment to Rule 2, Section 2. All those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I think I will have a Call of the House and a roll call vote. It doesn't look like we are going to get up there.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of the House going under Call vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays to go under Call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record your presence. All legislators are to be in their seats while the House is under Call. Senator DeCamp, will you declare your presence? Senator Goodrich. Senator Pirsch, will you please record your presence? Senator Newell, will you please record your presence? All who are not excused are present. The Legislature will please...please take your seats so we can proceed with the roll call vote. The issue is found on the bottom of page 23 of the Journal for January 7th, 1981. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 139, Legislative Journal.) 21 yes, 22 no, Mr. President, on adoption of the proposed rule change.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion fails. The amendment is not adopted. What is the next amendment.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler now moves to amend and his amendments are found on page 23 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Call is raised. We are on page 23. The Chair recognizes Senator Beutler.
