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worship the same God. If they did, we wouldn't have these various divisions. If there is one God, there should be one faith, one belief, one Bible, one baptism, but there is a King James version, a vulgate, and as many different Bibles as you can find people. There are Mormons, Episcopalians, Baptists, Lutherans, Methodists, and they are all supposed to be Christians. How many Christs were there? How many Gods are there? Everybody born of the same parents have the same last name. Then how can there be a Baptist and a Methodist and a Presbyterian and an Episcopalian all worshipping the same God? So they all stand together, getting sleep out of their eyes, looking down at the floor, shuffling, waiting for the prayer to get through. That's what it is, and I am not being as sacrilegious as those who go through the pretense every morning. But if you are going to put it in front of the Legislature like everything else, I have a right to deal with it like we do with everything around here. Money is very important. We talk disparagingly about money and money says, In God we Trust, and the God that is trusted is the money, and we know it because they are a lot more careful about what they do with that money than what they are with what they do about God. Everybody in here would give me all the prayer and religion I want but not everybody in here would give me five dollars. So we see where the values really are placed, and I think when the young people view the way older people deal with these things that are supposed to be sacred, the young people say, well, if that is all there is to it, I don't need that, it has no value and significance for me. These people do anything I would do and then they are going to tell me I am wrong. Why to get religious I have to become worse than I am now. If I were a believer, knowing how I feel about other things other than those things supernatural, I would be embarrassed to have something that means something to me handled in the way this Chaplain thing has been bandied about. Pay him with a cow or a pig or a chicken. Well better than that let's take up an offering and give it to him.
