CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Dworak would move to amend the Chambers amendment by adding in Rule 1, Section 2, where we have stricken "Chaplain" insert "Chaplain Coordinator".

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the Dworak amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Dworak's amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Dworak now moves to amend the Chambers amendment by inserting new language in Rule 1, Section 21, which would read: "The Chaplain Coordinator shall work in conjunction with Organized Nebraska Groups of Clergy to arrange for prayer at the beginning of each day of the Legislative Session." That is offered by Senator Dworak.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR DWORAK: My amendment was read as an amendment to Senator Chambers' amendment, but I don't believe we have had Senator Chambers' amendment. Is that right, Pat?

CLERK: No, sir, it is before us. We have considered it. He presented it.

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator Chambers' amendment addressed both sections?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR DWORAK: Okay. I think the amendment is selfexplanatory. There again it is the wording that the Exec Board approved of. It directs the Chaplain Coordinator to arrange with organized groups of Nebraska clergy to arrange for prayer before session.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, frankly I don't know what a Chaplain Coordinator is. Is he one who coordinates the Chaplain, or does he designate this individual who coordinates himself if he happens to be a Chaplain? I guess if he is walking down
