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you to know that there are several senators who I talked to before the rules debate began to urge them, because they had substantial rule changes, to work through the Rules Committee, to work through the process. Those senators were Senator Goodrich, Senator Maresh and Senator Warner who had rule changes pending before the Rules Committee. My promise to them was that we will deal with those rules changes, those substantial rules changes, through the Rules Committee process and we will get them back on the floor of the Legislature as soon as possible after we have resolved them and have a recommendation to make to the full body. Now I know that there are other rules changes that you have been thinking about, considering, there are rules changes that we have adopted that you are still concerned about but let me urge you to follow the leadership that has been shown by these other senators in working through the process. I am the Rules Committee chairman. You have elected me to that position. We have selected another four members. We are there to work on the rules, to adopt the rules and recommend to you changes that are necessary. I would urge you to use that process and as the institution that Senator Marvel, our Speaker, has referred to that is so important at this point because we have taken a great deal of time. We have given the attention proper to the rules but now we are at a point where the indecision of this body is leading to the chaos Speaker Marvel has talked about. The general public is uncertain. Those people who want to know about what bills will be introduced, how much help a senator can provide in terms of bill introductions, all these questions seem yet to be unresolved and the chaos that has resulted I think has stymied the body and I don't think we have the time with the ten day bill limitation period...

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have one minute.

SENATOR WESELY: ...to continue that situation. Let me just make this final comment. Senator Nichol commented on the fact that the blue copy is what we are considering and he would rather go back to the green copy or something like that. As Senator Beutler mentioned before, the blue copy was adopted last session. It was considered and adopted. We have amended that blue copy. We have taken the concerns that were expressed by different senators. We have changed it and I think made a very workable set of rules. It is now essential that we support the Speaker, that we support the institution and adopt as permanent rules, the remaining rules in the blue copy that we have discussed for three days and if there are concerns you have, I vow to work with you as Rules Committee chairman through the Rules Committee
