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to acknowledge the fact that you have lost and to back down. I guess as far as introduction of bills for a practical matter, that issue has been decided by this Legislature. Even if we amend the rules now or tomorrow to put a restriction on the number of bills that can be introduced, those who have wanted to introduce more than seventeen bills in two years have already had the opportunity to do that and we are not going to see that many more bills from Senator Nichol and Senator DeCamp and some of the other guys that want to bring them in in wheelbarrows. So I guess it is time...it is kind of a meaningless fight here this morning because as a practical consequence a limit on bill introduction now is relatively meaningless. So I think it is time to drop this fight for this year, perhaps impose some very tight restraints on what can be introduced in a sixty day session, that will solve some of our problems and also perhaps to cast a vote in favor of my proposed constitutional amendment when you have a chance to do that later on in the session. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, personally I am finding this discussion this morning to be delightful. It should be a learning experience for the new senators because it shows that what I had mentioned the other day is going to happen. We are not even on a serious issue yet in terms of consequences to the public and you see the fragile nature of all these agreements, alliances and so forth that occur and I hear the word "hypocrite" and so forth being tossed around. I was in my office and that is what brought me back down here because I thought after the prayer all of that would be over. We wouldn't have any more hypocrisy or these other things but I guess as Senator Higgins pointed out yesterday, it takes time to kind of overcome some of these simple failings of human beings but remember this in the discussion that is occurring here today, it is not taking time from other business because from what I look at there is no other business so everybody would be at home. But this has given the opportunity to have a thorough hashing out of various matters related, not only to the rules, because that only gives the occasion for the discussion, but as to what goes on behind the scenes in the background which is never discussed when the issue is before the Legislature, before the cameras and before the news media. So it shows that the public can still have a hoax worked on it because the one doing the speaking is not always the villain.
