CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Labedz' report is found on page 635 and involves appointments to the Game and Parks Commission.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Labedz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. The Committee on Constitutional Revision and Recreation desires to report favorably upon the appointment of Stan Juelfs. Stan Juelfs is from Kimball, Nebraska, 52 years old. His occupation, he is an oil man and businessman. He is President and Chairman of Stanco Petroleum Incorporated and he is Chairman of the Board of the Banner County Bank. He is a member of the Western Nebraska Sportsmen Club, the North Platte Valley Sportsmen Club, the Chimney Rock Hunting Club and the Nebraska Council of Sportsmen. So he does have a wide knowledge of the issues and problems of the Game and Parks Commission. The committee suggests the appointment be confirmed by this Legislature. Thank you.
