CLERK: Mr. President, the Public Works Committee, his report is found on page 642 and it involves individuals appointed to the Board of Public Roads Classifications and Standards and the Motor Vehicle Industry Licensing Board.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, may I ask a question? There are seven appointees we are dealing with here. Do you want to take them as a group or do you want to take them one at a time. There are seven. I would tell you that they were unanimously approved by the Public Works Committee. I will name them. If there is a question about any one of them, we have their resume here and I will give it to you. However, unless there is a request, I think that I will take the entire group, and if there is a question on any one, we will go back and review the resume. Is that okay?
