The second appointment is Mrs. Lois Roskens who is the wife of Ron Roskens, the President of the University of Nebraska. She is the mother of four children, very active in volunteer community work and a housewife. The third one, Jeanne Smith, is a resident of Gordan, Nebraska. She is married and has four children and used to be a teacher in several schools around and is now a housewife, and so I would strongly recommend all three of these to the Nebraska Arts Council.

Mrs. Majors lives at Osceola, Nebraska, has had a lot of background in education and in recent years has been active in a number of organizations including the WIFE organizations, Women in Farm Economics, and I have known Mrs. Majors for a number of years and I strongly support her in this new endeavor and hope that you will certainly lend your support to her appointment.
