PRESIDENT: Thanks, Senator Kahle. Any further discussion on Senator Kahle's report for the Government, Military Affairs Committee? If not, then the question is, shall the Government and Military Affairs Committee report be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs report.
