SENATOR CLARK PRESIDING

SENATOR CLARK: You have one minute left, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: ...and it is solely one of some kind of reasonable financial considerations for the expenditures of state funds in consideration of our entire budget over the next three or four years. I can tell you that there is going to be very little capital construction I suspect you will see this year. You will see very little next year and if we constantly tie up funds in the future we are back-logging a type of financial crisis in a renovation and maintenance of buildings. It is going to be extremely expensive. I appreciate the emotional argument that we go ahead with the vet college no matter what. I suppose there are those who would like to change maybe the name of an Institute of Agricultural and Natural Resources to the Veterinary College because almost the whole emphasis on agriculture is concentrated on this one structure and I have a real concern for the negative fallout that may occur for the rest of that campus function because of the argument that was centered around the Veterinary College and I would hope the body....

SENATOR CLARK: Your time is up, Senator.

SENATOR WARNER: ...would be reasonable in putting a reasonable termination date on which this issue is going to be before us. I urge adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Mr. Speaker and members, I rise to support the amendment and I would point out that there is some language in the amendment that Senator Warner was just discussing with you that is not in the bill and if we do not adopt this amendment the language will not be in any of the future amendments that I am aware of that are offered to this bill. It is one of the ones that brought up an issue that I tried to present to this body when this bill was on General File. The language is in Section 1 of the amendment and that section, under the provisions of the amendment, is not repealed or does not sunset and I think it is important that this body take that action. I attempted to offer to this body a compromise on General File that would sunset the provisions if the federal funds did not come but would, in fact, do something for veterinary medicine, for a veterinary education to
