I think in a time, this year and in coming years obviously with the tighter money situation due to federal pull backs this is a good place to save money and I think that we should stick by our previous action. We made the decision and let's go from here.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I hope the conservatives, those that acknowledge that that's what they are, will listen to me this morning. Senator Haberman offered a very substantial, acceptable, conservative proposition which would save a considerable amount of money for the state and deciding that on this instance the conservatives were right, I joined you. I think that you made a wise and proper decision. Now that I have gone out on the limb, joined the conservatives who are supposed to be predictable, solid and reliable, you are going to saw the limb out from under me and desert me. But what I must say is that once I am convinced of the rightness of a position then I have got to stick with it until my mind has been altered. Nothing that I have heard this morning has been different from anything that we heard the other day and despite those arguments I accepted the conservative position and I stick by it. Now if we want to influence people, we are going to have to show that we have well thought out our positions. So now that Senator Maresh has just about finished his cupcake, wiped his mouth I want to ask him a question and it won't take long so you can finish the rest when you answer this question. Senator Maresh, your amendment would return the bill and require two license plates rather than one, to state it in a nutshell, is that correct?

SENATOR MARESH: That is correct, Senator Chambers.
