I'd sure say there is your man. He didn't want to save any money. He is one of those big, big spenders. Let's go get him.

SENATOR NICHOL: Your time is up.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Mr. President, members, call for the question.
