And then Senator Newell says, "And, Senator DeCamp, you forgot the sunset provision." Senator DeCamp answers, "Yes, the sunset is tacitly in there, in the amendment anyway." Now what Senator Newell stood up here and didn't tell you is where the disagreement is and I will tell you where the damn disagreement is and you are being lied to again. The disagreement is over the issue...

SPEAKER NEWELL: (Gavel) Calm down.

SENATOR DeCAMP: ...of whether the other half of the Schmit amendment is still held in there, the revenue sharing thing. He never mentioned that. That is what it is all about. Heck, nobody is reluctant to go with your formula but, once again, you stood up on the critical issue and didn't tell the floor what it is all about and it is about the continuation of the rest of the bill, the switch to the revenue sharing.
