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support returning dollars to subdivisions because of what they might have lost in expectation of borrowing money. As I look at the subdivisions also, they did not budget totally for \$70 million. They budgeted \$59 million. That is what they budgeted for and so for us to make a declaration on the full 70 when their expectation was 59, again I think is not necessarily in our best interest, so I respectfully oppose Senator Kahle's amendment. One other thing, Mr. Chairman, I have another clip coming out here since Senator Hefner mentioned equity of state aid, and that is coming to your desk because I want you to see how the money is distributed when this Legislature last year liberally gave \$40 million to the public schools and I think it is going to be rather surprising because I still think it is a fair, equitable formula, probably one of the best this state has got in place.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called. All those in favor of ceasing debate...let's see, do I see five seconds, first of all? Okay, all those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. Okay, record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate has ceased. Okay, the closing is the DeCamp-Carsten amendment to the Kahle amendment. Senator DeCamp, you are closing.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I don't know personally whether there is really that much need to put a million and a half or seven hundred and fifty thousand or any amount in. I detect or sense a mood to put something in, to recognize that there was some loss to some people because they did not get their money in time. I guess in a courtroom we call it damages for pain and suffering or whatever. I do believe from my conversations with Senator Warner and some of the members of the Appropriations Committee that if we put the full million and a half in, we will possibly all regret it a little later when we get dealing with that pile of bills with A bills in the right hand column. For that reason I am suggesting seven hundred and fifty thousand is an amount that probably isn't going to hurt anybody that much, would recognize the lost money if you want to say that, whatever. I would like to yield the
