change, so what is the big fight? Let's have a little give and take and say we have no sunset now and let's have no sunset in this one. It only takes 25 votes to change it. Let's see if there is a unity. Let's see if we are really going to get 33 votes on this bill, and this is one way to see if we are going to do that, because that is what it is going to take. Nobody is going to get a nickel if we don't. So let's just see if there is some sort of cooperation between the two factions. if there are two factions and if they are fighting. So let's take the sunset out, and let the bill go ahead and play it that way. Let's play the game, Senator Marsh, right across the front of the table, what's fair for one is fair for the other. Now that some people seem to have what they want, let's see that the other side gets what they want, so if they don't want any sunset, let them have it. It's going to change anyway next year or the year after that, we all know that. And I agree with you, the issue is to get the money back to the people. The sunset provision being out of there will still get the money back to them, Senator Marsh. So I would urge the body to accept the motion and let's go ahead. Thank you. Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Vickers.

SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, I call the question.

SENATOR CLARK: Do I see five hands? I do. All those that wish to cease debate will vote aye. All those opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 mays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Debate is ceased. Senator Lamb, do you wish to close?

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, it has been brought to my attention that my amendment should also strike Section 7 of the amendment in order to be consistent. But this is not a big issue with me and I want to assure Senator Marsh and others that I am going to support the bill whether or not this amendment is adopted. I am not trying to delay the bill. I am only saying that I am trying to add consistency. If we thought the bill yesterday should not have the sunset
