

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you. When the debate was on General File Senator Chambers questioned me about the line where we state per week and after performed, so what we are doing here is changing that to correct the language putting in "During any one calendar week". We are also adding the severability clause which will take care of some of the concerns that Senator Chambers has, also the emergency clause and coming up later I have two other amendments but this one will just correct some language and put the emergency clause and the severability clause in case any part of the bill is unconstitutional. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: How does the amendment read, Pat? Okay, the motion is the adoption of Senator Labeledz's first motion to LB 466. Senator Higgins, do you want to speak to that motion?

SENATOR HIGGINS: Yes, Mr. Speaker, just to the extent that I would like to add to Senator Chambers remarks that I think it is going to be more interesting to see whether or not the Governor can be goaded by Senator Chambers. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the Labeledz amendment number one vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Mr. Speaker, I'm very reluctant but we need one more vote. I'm sure that there are a lot of senators in their office that would just be dying to come up and vote on this bill.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Record the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Labeledz amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion carried.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators Fowler and Landis now move to indefinitely postpone the bill. That would lay it over.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Since we discussed indefinitely postpone would that still lay it over? We had one.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The original motion was withdrawn before a vote was taken.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Then I would like to make a motion to suspend the rules and take it up today.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, you heard the motion. Is there further discussion? Senator Beutler, your light is on.
