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I have to eat and sometimes I have to stay overnight, but according to these Lincoln senators, I can't use any of my campaign funds, either in season when I am running, or out of season when I am not running. So they don't evidently understand the problem of campaigning because you put up some signs and you knock on some doors and you buy some ads and you go on the radio and you are elected. But that isn't the way the real world is outside of the confines of Lincoln. Let the people be the judge. I am not afraid of the people of my district judging me by voting me in or out about how I spend the money they give me or how much I get from a lobbyist. I am not ashamed of this. Then I will take it and I declare it. You can't legislate morality. If you put these laws in they are going to find ways around them if they want to get around them. I don't see the need to add more junk bills to the bills we already have. From the tone of this bill everybody is a crook. That is what they are saying and I don't think that is true. I think we are all big boys and we can be responsible for how we spend the money. If they don't like how we spend it they won't give it to us. It sure is funny that we can't accept a gift from a lobbyist or an organization but we can accept a contribution and I would like to have somebody explain the difference between a gift and a contribution. It is exactly the same thing but the man that runs the Public Accountability Committee told me this. He said, Rex, try and find out for me, will you, what the difference between a gift and a contribution is. There isn't any difference. So, I would have to support the kill motion, however, if it doesn't pass, I would like to have everybody read Johnny DeCamp's amendment. I think they are great and I will support them. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, members of the body, I rise to support the kill motion. If you will look in your bill book you will see that I voted against this bill, voted against advancement at General File, and the reason I did this is because I feel that the bill is very vague. The bill prohibits the use of campaign funds for specific purposes and let me just talk about some of the things that are in the bill. About your clothing, you cannot use funds to buy clothes with. You cannot use campaign funds to pay your dental expenses or your medical expenses, installment payments on an automobile. I submit to you today, what do we do when Senator DeCamp goes out in his pickup and campaigns? It doesn't say anything about a pickup, just automobile. And so, I think that the bill is very vague and what are personal services? Does that mean when you have to buy a meal on the road when you are campaigning, you can't use
