SENATOR HIGGINS: I call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay, all those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Okay, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Debate has ceased. The Chair recognizes Senator Marsh to close on her motion, on her amendment.

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, the amendment on page 1540 is designed to be an answer to one specific problem as I saw it. That is problem is not directly before us now but I am trying to alert this body that there is a proposal which would limit the dollar amount from an individual pack. That effort does not solve the problem from my perspective. The proposed piece of legislation before you allows more flexibility for a candidate than would a proposed amendment which would say you may accept seven hundred and fifty dollars from an individual pack when you might wish to accept fifteen hundred from that individual pack. This is an option which I offer to this body as a part of the total package. There are sections of 134 which do not please me. There are sections of 134 I fully support and like much of our legislation you have to lump it all together. The amendment on page 1540 is before you for your choice at this time.

SPEAKER MARVEL: All those in favor of the adoption of the Marsh amendment vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Marsh. Okay, record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Marsh amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion lost.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is from Senator DeCamp, referred to as Request #2322.

SPEAKER MARVEL: In the North balcony from Senator Newell's district, 48 students, 12th grade, Roncalli High School, Omaha, Nebraska, instructor Carl Wirth. Where are you located? Okay, and from Senator Sieck's district, 49 students from the 12th grade, York High School, York, Nebraska, Larry Felt, teacher, also in the North balcony. Where are you located. There we are, over here. Okay. Senator DeCamp.
