SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I respectfully call the question.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? Okay, all those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote no. The vote is to cease debate. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. Debate ceases. Senator Chambers, do you wish to close? Okay. The motion is the adoption of the Chambers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, I would like a Call of the House and a roll call vote so that the time can be compressed.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Shall the House go under Call? All those in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to go under Call.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The House is under Call. All legislators should be in your seats, record your presence, ask unauthorized personnel to leave the floor please. Senator Burrows, Senator Warner, Senator Lamb, Senator Lowell Johnson, Senator Howard Peterson, Senator Vard Johnson, Senator Goodrich, Senator Landis, Senator Newell, Senator Pirsch. We are missing Senator Lamb and Senator Pirsch and Senator Vard Johnson and Senator Newell. Senator Lamb, you are here, okay. Adoption of the Chambers amendment. Senator Chambers, we have everybody but Senator Pirsch and Senator Newell. Call the roll.

CLERK: (Read roll call vote as found on page 1625 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 30 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Motion lost.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have is offered by Senator Lowell Johnson and it is found on page 1571.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The Call is raised. Senator Lowell Johnson.
