It is a little incongruous sometime for a man to buy a \$4000 ad in a newspaper and then find on the editorial page that some unnamed editorial writer says, oh Joe Blow is not a very good guy and we think his opponent ought to be elected. So I think you get to the point where, for example, suppose that we tighten down the accountability law so strict that everything is going to be disclosed as we want it to be, if you do not adopt this amendment, Senator Wesely and I could organize a Save Your Czech Heritage Society, accept contributions, make speeches, expend funds and I don't think we would have to report a dime. Why then go through the embarrassment of taking in political contributions? You could support yourself through this kind of a procedure and it would be legal and above board, and you wouldn't have to be blasted with spending huge amounts of money. If I could put my picture on a full page ad three times, I don't need to spend money for political ads or billboards, or anything else. Senator Dworak is right in that position when he says as members of an elected body....

SPEAKER MARVEL: You have one minute.

SENATOR SCHMIT: ...we have access to the media. But I believe, ladies and gentlemen, that there is a major... there will be a major shift in activities by organizations towards this kind of activity unless we try to require some accountability. Now I agree with Senator Dworak it may be too broad, but if we find it is too broad in six or seven months we could come back here and narrow it down, and on the other hand if we find it does a good job, I think we may very well be glad that we have it. I ask that you support the amendment and plug a loophole that is large enough to drive a Union Pacific coal train through.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is the adoption of the Schmit amendment. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted.
