SENATOR NICHOL: Do you wish to withdraw it?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, we are seeing sunshinism in full blossom today and I would be the last to interfere with the blooming.

SENATOR NICHOL: Any objections? It is withdrawn. Okay now we are back to the Schmit amendment. Senator Beutler, did you wish to speak to the Schmit amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I would just like to ask Senator Schmit a couple of questions, if I may.

SENATOR NICHOL: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I yield, Mr. President.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Schmit, would you tell me what it is that attorneys are not now disclosing because of the attorney/client privilege which will be disclosed once your amendment passes?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Senator, when my amendment passes, the attorneys will disclose all the information that any other candidate is required to disclose.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Specifically, Senator Schmit, what is that information?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Not being an attorney, Senator Beutler, I don't know what you have not disclosed.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, Senator Schmit, you are familiar with the Political Accountability Act, exactly what requirement is it we are not disclosing right now?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, Senator, apparently you are not disclosing something because you are vigorously opposing this amendment. If you are disclosing everything you there's nothing to fix about it.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Schmit, I am just opposing this because I think it's nonsense and I.....

SENATOR NICHOL: Gentlemen, gentlemen....

SENATOR BEUTLER:would like to know exactly what it is that we are not disclosing. Could you please just name one thing that we are not disclosing that this
