of food up to \$50 is already covered in the law under Section 49-1415 and I think that to include that into the law now would be redundant, confusing and would trash the law, and so I am simply suggesting that what Senator Schmit is asking for here is already being done and that we delete that portion of the amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I fully support the Beutler amendment. He is completely correct. I think when Senator Schmit picked up the language he got it from the proposal I offered this morning and, of course, we had a complete rewrite in there, therefore, we had to include that language, so Senator Beutler is simply striking the extraneous portion and nobly, I might say, leaving in the essence of the Schmit amendment. So I fully support it and hope you will too and then I hope Senator Beutler supports the Schmit amendment which says we are now going to have equal reporting of \$100 of value in labor or \$100 in cash contribution.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion before the House is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to the Schmit amendment. All in favor of that vote aye, opposed vote no. Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Beutler amendment to the Schmit amendment.

SPEAKER MARVEL: The motion is carried. The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler moves to amend the Schmit amendment. (Read the second Beutler amendment as found on page 1635 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER MARVEL: Go ahead.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, this is also intended to be a clean-up amendment. Those words are being dropped so that the amendment would now read, "The campaign statement of a committee shall disclose the value of services provided without compensation", etcetera, etcetera. Noncash contributions are covered in the law presently. The only thing that is not covered that Senator Schmit wants to cover, I believe, are personal voluntary personal services, and by dropping that extraneous language having to do with noncash contributions
