SENATOR LABEDZ: I see.

SENATOR DeCAMP: But right now it is illegal.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Right now I am illegal?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, Bernice, I told you, beady-eyes and

all that.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Oh, my God, first illegal thing I've done in the Legislature. I'm sorry about that.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Well, anyway this...if you adopted the amendment it would address this particular problem....

SENATOR LABEDZ: Okay.

SENATOR DeCAMP: ...and I really believe....

SENATOR LABEDZ: Your amendment?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Okay, to the amendment. Thank you, Senator

De Camp.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Senator Koch. Okay, Senator Nichol, do you wish to close on your amendment? The Chair recognizes Senator Nichol to close on his amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chalrman, I agree to the DeCamp amendment. What it does is this....(interruption).

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{SPEAKER}}$ MARVEL: Senator Nichol, we are discussing your amendment.

SENATOR NICHOL: Well, I thought Senator DeCamp had submitted an amendment to my amendment. All right. Mr. Chairman, Mr. Chairman. Mr. Chairman.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator DeCamp, do you wish to offer your amendment to the Nichol amendment?

SENATOR DeCAMP: Yes, sir, and I have already explained it. It clears up an area I think that is a serious area. I don't think because you people ride in to a necessary job for the benefit of the state that you should be criminals.

SPEAKER MARVEL: Okay, Senator Lamb, do you wish to speak
